

WAMM-Freedom & Music FESTIVAL

Dear Friend & Community Member;

It's that time of year again where we thank the community with our free music festival. This year WAMM's Freedom and Music Festival will take place on October 22nd, 2011, from 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., at San Lorenzo Park. Our annual celebration was born in response to the Bush Administration's attack on our collective garden. In 2002, thirty armed DEA agents raided the home of WAMM founders, Mike and Valerie Corral, arresting them at gunpoint. Agents then used chainsaws to hack down the garden.

WAMM staged a powerful response. Ten days after the raid, WAMM members responded by having a meeting on the steps of City Hall and provided free medical marijuana to our members. Fortified by the support of our community, WAMM, the Santa Cruz City Council, and the County Board of Supervisors joined in a lawsuit to stop the aggression of the federal government. The raid was intended to be a blow from which we could never recover; instead it prompted us into action.

The following year we thought it was important to respond. In an attempt to dispel the feelings of loss, anguish and fear brought into the lives of our sick and dying members by government forces, we staged our first free community celebration in Santa Cruz. WAMMfest was born.

WAMM's Freedom and Music Festival is a way to say thank you to the city of Santa Cruz and the community as a whole for all the support throughout the years. It's also an event to enrich awareness and promote the civil liberties of sick and dying patients through medical marijuana, and a fundraiser to help us continue the services that we have been provided since 1993.

We are proud to help our community with the highest degree of integrity and the understanding that the true value of marijuana is not in the cost, but in its ability to relieve suffering. We depend on the generosity of our community to help us continue our services. Your support is essential. Join us for a memorable Saturday with your friends and family. WAMM's Freedom and Music Festival is FREE for everyone and we expect a very large community turnout. Terms & Conditions

Please make check payable to WAMM and supply us with the artwork via e-mail it to: info@wamm.org, we will also need your registration contract. A commercial use fee must be paid to the City on all revenue generated on public property at a special event. The cost of this fee is 10% of gross revenue for commercial businesses and 5% of gross revenue for non-profit organizations.

There is **no selling of alcohol or medical marijuana on grounds**; vendors or organizations that sell or serve alcohol or medical marijuana will be escorted out of the park, their contracts will be terminated immediately. Furthermore, the organization must still abide with the commercial use fee to the City of Santa Cruz.

Booth space and fixtures: if you need additional chairs and tables, please indicate in the comments section, additional costs will apply. Canopies are also available for a fee, as well as shady spots, upon request.

Food Vendors: by completing and signing the contract you will be securing your spot on the vendor roster, as well as guaranteeing that you will be the only food vendor from your particular type of cuisine. We do not duplicate foods. Food vendors must also adhere with the Environmentally Acceptable Food Packaging Ordinance of Santa Cruz. The latter means only biodegradable, compostable or recyclable food containers are allowed; styrofoam containers are not allowed.

We appreciate your support and know that our community does too. That's good publicity and karma for you, plus great appreciation from the community. Proceeds will help WAMM in our efforts to change unfair laws, protect patients and their rights, promote research, and provide general support to our members and community.
